### 1. SPONSOR A FESTIVAL ACTIVITY OR SERVICE:

Underwrite one of these festival activities or services:

- A. Print 10,000 11X14 full color, 2-sided maps with activities and sponsors: \$750
- B. Rental of mobile sound stage: \$750
- C. Rent tents, tables and chairs for activities, and information stations \$900
- D. Entertainment for children including face-painting, clowns, magician, and acrobats, \$1,000
- E. Painting street banners, 4x8 park banners, print 40 lawn directional signs, \$1,200
- F. Children's workshops for kite-making, puppet-making, arts & crafts, and painting oil drums: \$1,200
- G. Music program provides four hours of live local musical groups: \$1,500
- H. Print 10,000 full color, two sided flyers plus 300 14X18 posters: \$1,600

- b. Custom painted drums are based on an estimate after describing your preferences
